34 Children and Teens Attend Camp Hope

Camp Hope 2011 was held at Camp Mohaven in Danville, Ohio. Campers arrived Monday morning, met their "Big" (an adult who became their buddy for the duration of camp), got settled into their cabin and joined together for the opening ceremony of camp. 34 campers stayed busy (as did the staff!) until our closing ceremony on Wednesday. Campers attended various groups in which they explored ways to address and cope with the thoughts and feelings associated with the loss of their loved one. Campers were given the



opportunity to create a variety of projects including memory bracelets, a group "feelings" mural and honor banners to commemorate the individual who had died. In addition to the groups, campers rode horses (always identified by the kids as a favorite!), went canoeing, swam, played games and sang songs. Tuesday evening, campers and staff roasted hotdogs. In a special ceremony, campers remembered their loved one. There were lots of tears and hugs as campers "sent" letters through use of the campfire. S'mores were enjoyed by all prior to turning in for the night. Closing ceremony on Wednesday morning after breakfast included each camper being re-introduced by their Big and the sharing of the specialness of each camper. Balloons were released and 34 tired campers said their good-byes to camp.
